Step 1.

Hold a circle time discussion in your class. There are some suggestions below you could use, or you could adapt these questions to suit your class:

- · Does anybody know what the word well-being means?
- Who or what helps to keep you happy, healthy and safe in school?
- What else could your school do to keep you happy, healthy and safe?

Step 2.

Create a presentation for your school's Senior Leadership Team and/or the school's governors to illustrate your circle time discussions. This could be a verbal presentation, a display or a video.*
