- Lots of you enjoyed being with your family on the way to school. You told us you like chatting to your family



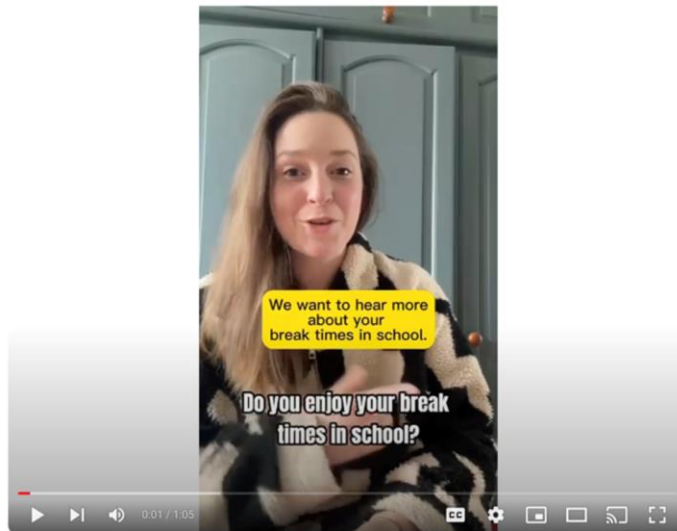
- Some of you liked singing and listening to the radio on the way to school.

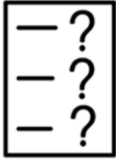


1) Discuss in pairs or as a group:
